What do you think God is saying to you in this scripture? Ask the Holy Spirit to teach you and reveal Jesus to you through the Scripture. Make an observation of what's happening, who's affected, and what's taking place. Paraphrase and write this Scripture down in your own words in your journal.

APPLICATION

Personalize what you have read, by asking yourself "how will I be different today because of what I've just read?". Perhaps it is instruction, encouragement, revelation of a new promise, or corrections for a particular area of your life. Write how this Scripture can apply to you today.

PRAYER

This can be as simple as asking God to help you use this Scripture, or it may be a greater insight on what He may be revealing to you.
